

NCPHA Women's and Children's Health Section Scholarship
In Memory of Dr. Ann F. Wolfe

The NCPHA Women's and Children's Health (WCH) Section Scholarship Committee is pleased to announce that scholarships will be available for applicants that meet the following criteria:

1. The Dr. Ann F. Wolfe scholarships shall be awarded at the Annual Educational Conference of the North Carolina Public Health Association to a nurse working in a Child Health, Family Planning, Maternal Health or BCCCP program of a public health department in North Carolina.
2. Awards for public health training shall be limited to nursing staff who are requesting or required to attend one of the following training programs: Child Health Enhanced Role, Adult Health Assessment or Specialty Tracks: Maternal Health and Family Planning Enhanced Role.
3. The applicant(s) must confirm in writing that it is his/her intent to work in their public health agency in North Carolina for at least two (2) years following completion of training. Applications must be submitted to the WCH Scholarship Committee by June 15th.
4. The recipient(s) must be a current member(s) of NCPHA.
5. The recipient(s) must be eligible to attend the advanced training. The following factors will be taken into account in selecting scholarship recipients(s):
 - Current position and training requirements
 - Community need for the provision of the WCH service in their agency by an advanced level practitioner
 - Financial need and/or hardship to the local agency with financing the cost of the training and associated expenses
6. A letter of recommendation and confirmation from the Health Director or the Nursing Supervisor of the local health department is to be submitted with the application to verify the scholarship request by the nurse and the agency's need for the nurse to attend the advanced clinical or enhanced role training.
